Updated Out-of-Uniform Day Guidelines (10/14/2022)

On occasion, including birthdays, students may be permitted an out-of-uniform day. We expect the attire to be appropriate, modest, well-fitting, and clean. No article of clothing should be excessively worn or soiled. Indecent, inappropriate, or objectionable writing/pictures that espouse beliefs contrary to the teachings of the Catholic Church on clothing is prohibited. Clothing must cover the body appropriately. A shirt long enough to cover the backside must be worn if wearing leggings.

Clothing NOT allowed on dress down or spirit wear days include, but not limited to:

- halter tops
- ripped jeans
- transparent or mesh tops
- short t-shirts (baby t's for example creating bare midriffs)
- any top which leaves bare shoulders (including tank tops)
- shorts cut too short
- backless shoes
- sandals
- hats
- bandanas
- distracting head pieces

The Administration reserves the right to make the final decision regarding the appropriateness of student dress. If a student does not follow proper guidelines for dressing out of uniform, a parent/guardian will be called to bring the school uniform or clothing that is considered within the guidelines.
