

## **Addendum 2 to The Road Forward Plan dated March 2, 2022**

On March 7, 2022, St. Bartholomew School will no longer require that our students, teachers, and staff wear masks in the school. Any employee or student who wants to continue to wear a mask is welcome to do so and is fully supported by the school administration.

In an ongoing effort to maintain the health and well-being of all those in our school, we will be guided by the following:

1. During periods of elevated community transmission, when the COVID-19 Activity Level Index (CALI) is very high (RED), the school will require universal masking for all students and staff. If the CALI score is high (ORANGE), the school should consider universal masking for all, especially if there is any difficulty incorporating safety measures such as physical distancing or adequate ventilation.
2. If there is an active outbreak in school or a general increase in cases of COVID-19, the Local Health Department will be consulted to determine if short term masking for all or for specific classrooms should be required.
3. Anyone testing positive for COVID-19 will be required to quarantine. The person may either quarantine for 10 days or return after 5 days with a mask for days 6-10.
4. If a student rides a bus, the students must follow the guidelines presented by the bus. If there is a mask requirement, the student is obligated to abide by that regulation.
5. In the case of field trips, students will be obligated to follow the guidelines presented by the site being visited. If they require masks, students will be obligated to abide by that regulation.
