Individuals are required to wear masks.

A parent or legal guardian must accompany children less than 18 years of age. Parents of minors must bring a government-issued form of identification. Saint Peter's child life specialists are available to assist anyone 12-18 who may need a sensory-friendly environment when receiving the Pfizer COVID vaccine. If your child has sensory issues and/or is anxious or fearful of injections, our child life team can offer support through coping skills and distraction techniques.
