Dear Parents or Guardians,

It is hard to believe that we are about two weeks away from the beginning of the school year. The school is alive with teachers preparing their classrooms for the arrival of our students. This week, I'd like to tell you about our afterschool program and extra curricular clubs and activities that will resume for the 2022-2023 school year.

As many of you know, we have a full after-care program for the students at St. Bart's. This program is an affordable option for families who need extended care for their school-aged children after daily dismissal. There is additional information on the school's website under the academics & programs tab. This year, we're excited to have many clubs and activities return for our students.

Extracurricular clubs and activities will be broken up into three different sessions, Fall (September-Christmas), Winter (January-Easter), and Spring (after Easter-late May). Each session will offer a variety of activities for our students. These activities will be broken down by age group and run on different days. Teachers and outside vendors will be offering these activities.

Monday through Thursday we will offer Homework Club for those families who would like to have direct teacher support for homework. There is an extra fee for this if your child is not in after-care. Other clubs and activities will run on various days and specific information will be coming home within the first week of school about the days, dates and fees for these activities. They include:
