- Skip counting by twos, fives, and tens C.4

Time:

- Match digital clocks and times: FF.1
- Match analog clocks and times: FF.2
- Read clocks and write times: FF.4

Shapes:

- Name the two-dimensional shapes KK.1
- Name the three-dimensional shapes LL.2

Fractions:

- Equal Parts- halves and fourths NN.1
