Before you enter the sixth grade, we recommend that you purchase the following items during the summer:

6 2-pocket folders or	small box of crayons and markers (24 count or less)

several red pens	pencils (4 sharpened every day before class)
erasers	sharp scissors

You should work on the following topics from the fifth grade Language Arts and Math sections of **IXL** for at least 40 minutes per week during the summer:

ELA: Theme (B 1), Literary Devices (F 1-4), Organizing Writing (Q 1-6), Introductions and Conclusion (R 1-2), Developing and Supporting Arguments (T 1-5), Editing and Revising (W 1-3)

Math: Multiplication (C.1-C.9), Division (D.1-D.8), Add and Subtract Fractions (L.3), Fraction Review (K.1), Place Value (A.2)

Science:, Materials (A), Physical and Chemical Change (D), Units and Measurement (W.2,W.4, and W.6), Identify Lab Tools (X),
